A driving force behind the book is Philip Levine's poem *What Work Is*, which Kass believes attempts to examine not only the dignity and complexity of what we think physical, tangible work is but also the exhausting, albeit sometimes fulfilling nature of emotional work. *Teacher/Pizza Guy* is a funny and relatable collection for readers, thinkers, educators, and pizza lovers everywhere.
